

**Catherine (Kate) Drost** is Associate Counsel, Army Materiel Command, Redstone Arsenal, Alabama.

Since 2011, Ms. Drost has served in the Business Law Branch at the Office of Command Counsel, Army Materiel Command (AMC).

She provides legal advice and counsel in connection with AMC logistics and supply operations; serves as Counsel to the HQ AMC Contracting Support Element; and also serves as AMC Procurement Fraud and Irregularities Coordinator.



Ms. Drost came to AMC from the Defense Logistics Agency, where she served from 1983 – 2011 in both the Office of General Counsel and field contract operations assignments.

From 2009 – 2011, she was Counsel to DLA Huntsville, Alabama, which purchases repairable aviation and missile parts for the Army Aviation and Missile Command.

Prior to that, as an associate general counsel at DLA Headquarters from 1988 - 2009, she served in a variety of acquisition-related capacities, including procurement fraud and contractor suspension and debarment.

From 2001 through 2009, she served as DLA Legal Member of the Defense Acquisition Regulation Council, which promulgates Federal Acquisition Regulation and DoD FAR Supplement changes.

Ms. Drost began her legal career with the Navy, serving on active duty in the Navy Judge Advocate General's Corps from 1979 - 1982.

She received her JD from the Dickinson School of Law of the Pennsylvania State University and her BA in philosophy and history from Indiana University of Pennsylvania.
